


INDUSTRY CHANGES

NAIT

There have been some recent changes to our NAIT system. NAIT numbers now go with the parcel of land, not the person. If you have relocated it is important that you and your staff know your correct NAIT number.

Dehorning

From the 1st of October, effective pain relief will be required during both disbudding calves and dehorning cattle, and the person carrying out the procedure must be trained and competent. Dairy NZ has more information on this on their website.

Once again we will be rearing around 5,000 calves this Spring. Our overarching focus is to Keep Things Super Simple. As our business has grown it takes a lot more management, so we are focused on being clear and keeping things simple, so our staff can do their jobs well.

Changes

Milk

Direct from farm is a really valuable food for our calves. If you have surplus colostrum or down graded milk we are keen to buy it. Please phone 027 265 7144. Our phone is monitored 24/7. There is a 1,000L/pickup minimum, price will be 15c/L + GST.

Calves

We will be buying some calves directly from the paddock through two agents, so if you want to sell your calves to us please contact Kelly Higgins (Carrfields) on 027 600 2374 or Regan Craig (Wrightsons) on 027 5028 585. We don't have enough staff to do this job ourselves, so rely on these well-respected agents to do this for us. We will be buying Friesian Bulls and White Faced Bulls, with the price being market rate. We will also buy calves from the sale yards and are also rearing 2,000 calves for a large corporate group again too.


